

...they have greatly reduced the inflow into the gravity systems where they have been installed. By reducing the inflow, there are several benefits that will be realized over the lifetime of the sewer system such as reduction in electrical costs, reduction of wear and tear on the pump stations, increase capacity within the system for future development, reduction of overflows into ditches, etc. The inserts also provide a means for the system to ventilate which greatly reduces the sewer gases that corrode and destroy manholes, lines and pumping equipment.
